ABOUT ONEWALK:

- The Rexall OneWalk to Conquer Cancer is a 15KM, 25KM, 40KM or up to 55KM walk throughout the iconic streets and communities of Toronto and an inspiring festival experience, to raise vital funds for Princess Margaret Cancer Centre and help conquer all forms of cancer.
- An estimated one in two Canadians will develop cancer in their lifetimes, and one in four will die from it. In 2017, an estimated 206,200 new cases of cancer and 80,800 cancer deaths will occur Canada. The Rexall OneWalk to Conquer Cancer brings together communities of participants, survivors and their supporters for one common goal: to conquer cancer in this lifetime.
- Funds raised through the Rexall OneWalk to Conquer Cancer support Personalized Cancer Medicine at Princess Margaret Cancer Centre, one of the top-five cancer research centres in the world. This support enables our world-leading clinicians and researchers to detect cancers earlier, diagnose with more precision, target treatment for each patient and support patients and their families throughout the cancer journey.
- The 2017 Rexall OneWalk to Conquer Cancer raised \$6,078,000. Since 2003, supporters of The Princess Margaret have walked to help conquer cancer in all its forms. To date over \$168 million has been raised. 2018 marks 16 years of walking to conquer cancer.
- The Rexall OneWalk to Conquer Cancer is The Princess Margaret's next generation fundraiser. With OneWalk, participants choose to fundraise as a team or individually and designate the fundraising dollars to the cancer research that matters most to them.
- When a participant registers, they select a cancer fund that their dollars raised will support, such as: *Discovery Research, Breast, Gynaecologic, Lung, Gastrointestinal, Hepatobiliary, Genitourinary, Blood Cancers, Endocrine, Skin Cancer and Melanoma, Head and Neck Cancers, Central Nervous System Cancers, Brain and Eye Cancer, Sarcoma, Childhood Cancers, Supportive Care, Patient Education and Radiation Medicine.*
- Upon registration, participants also select the distance they will complete. On Friday, September 7, participants may complete the 15KM Night Walk. On Saturday, September 8, participants may walk 15KM in the Morning Circuit, 25KM in the Walker Favourite, 40KM in the "Marathon" or up to 55KM in the Two-Day, Your Way option, completing the 15KM Night Walk and one of the Saturday options.
- Princess Margaret Cancer Centre has the largest cancer research and clinical program in Canada. As global leaders in cancer care, The Princess Margaret has the expertise to treat over 200 types of cancers, including the rarest forms of the disease. Princess Margaret Cancer Centre has a rich history of research excellence, discovery and innovation. Every day, oncologists at The Princess Margaret combine clinical strength with the research expertise of The Campbell Family Cancer Research Institute to deliver breakthrough cancer research, treatments and patient-centred care.
- Participants are supported by hundreds of volunteers and crewmembers, providing meals, water and snack stops, portable restrooms, safety on the course, comprehensive medical services and an evening festival complete with activities and entertainment.
